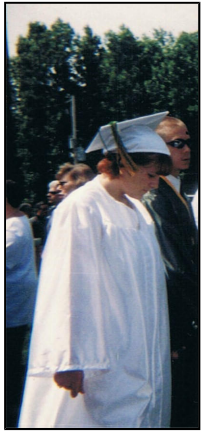

Could I believe, her spirit blessed me there

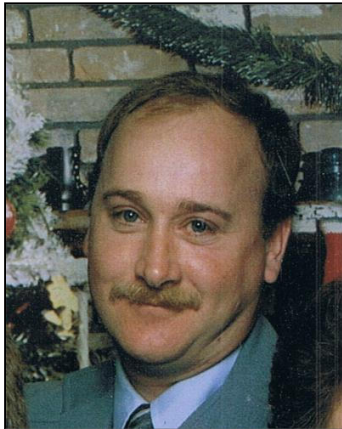
Her eyes so bright they shown with love

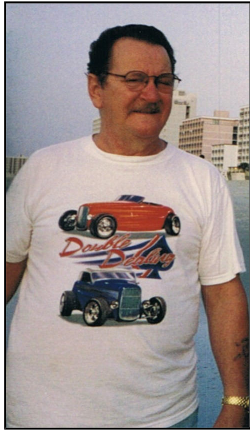

She had one brother, Lucas James Lawson. When Lucas' first son Zachary was born in March 2003 Tina was there at the hospital to welcome Zachary here. Tina's first job was at Hardees in Stuart, Virginia. Later on she worked at a popular place called The Village Market. There she met her husband Robby. Also she worked there with a girl named Angie who became Tina's best friend. Later on she got a job at Hanesbrands in Woolwine. Then she bought her a new, a blue ford focus car in 2002. She got married in 2002 to Robby Hutchens but they never had any children. They lived in Bassett Virginia. Tina was a good girl. She had so many friends and she would help anybody she could. She was a poet and loved to listen to music. Tina collected porcelin dolls. Her favorite color was blue. Tina thought there was nobody like her
